

I. DEMOGRAPHICS

A. POPULATION

Miami-Dade County, home to over 2.3 million residents, is the largest and most populated county in the state and the eight largest in the country. Estimates released by the Department of Planning and Zoning for the county reflect a population increase to 2.5 million people by 2010, or a 6% increase since 2004.

Table 1 illustrates the diversity that characterizes the county and provides a demographic summary of the race and ethnicity of the population. Between 2000 and 2004, people who reported themselves as White constituted the largest racial/ethnic group, accounting for over 1.5 million in 2000 to over 1.7 million in 2004. However, this racial/ethnic group has the slowest growth rate in the county, 5.0% from 2000-2004. By contrast, people who classified themselves as "Other" experienced the greatest increase in population (12.9% from 2000-2004). The Hispanic population also showed a significant increase (10.2%) over the reference years, and comprises nearly 60% of the county's total population.

In 2004, the 65 and older age group constituted the largest segment of the population in Miami-Dade (13.4%), closely followed by the 35-39 year age group throughout the eight-year period.

Females have consistently surpassed the number of males who reside in the county, and accounted for approximately 52% of the population in the eight-year period. The number of females of childbearing age (between 15-44 years old) increased from 2.1 million to almost 2.4 million over the reference period; however, this represents a decreasing percentage of the entire female population, as the population continues to age.

B. GEOGRAPHIC REGIONS

Access to official birth, death and linked files provided by the FLDOH allowed the execution of zip code level analysis and review of countywide data. In addition, The Health Council of South Florida provided zip code specific data for many demographic factors that are useful for the examination and review of the health status of any given zip code or geographic region. The attachments on the following pages include data on demographic factors that will facilitate the description of geographic areas and neighborhoods.

For planning purposes, and to facilitate the distribution of Healthy Start services in Miami-Dade County, the Coalition divides Miami-Dade County into the following three planning regions:

North Miami-Dade

North Miami-Dade is located in the northern section of Miami-Dade County. The North to South boundaries stretch from N.E. 215th Street (the Broward County line) to N.W. 20th Street. The East to West boundaries run from the Atlantic Ocean to US Highway 27 (Okeechobee Road) while the beaches are also considered as part of the North Miami-Dade region. Twenty-nine zip codes comprise North Miami-Dade that houses an estimated 1,018,222, or 46.3% of the total county population. A high concentration of Blacks (31.6%) compared to 9.8% in the remainder of the county dominate the ethnic composition of the region. See Map I. for the zip codes included in this planning region.

Central Miami-Dade

In Central Miami-Dade, the North to South boundaries extend from Okeechobee Road (SR27) to South Dixie Highway and Kendall Drive (S.W. 88 Street). The East to West boundaries run from the Atlantic Ocean to Krome Avenue (179th Avenue). The area encompasses a 32 zip code region occupied by an estimated 766,320 residents that represent 34.9% of the county population. The ethnic composition is dominated by a high concentration of people of Hispanic origin; 78.2% compared to 46.3% in the remainder of the county. See Map I.2 for the zip codes included in the Central Miami-Dade planning region.

South Miami-Dade

South Miami-Dade is located at the southern region of Miami-Dade County. The boundaries include Kendall Drive (S.W. 88 Street) to the North, Monroe County line to the South, Biscayne Bay to the East, and the Florida Everglades to the West. There are 18 zip codes in this suburban and rural area known for its agricultural industry. According to the CACI Marketing Systems, the region houses an estimated 410,237 residents that represent 18.7% of the total county population. See Map I.3 for the zip codes included in the South Miami-Dade planning region.

Attachments I-A, I-B and I-C contain zip-code specific demographic data, data on the insured and data on Medicaid recipients for each of the three planning regions, respectively.

C. HOUSEHOLD SIZE AND INCOME

In 2004, there were 821,081 households in Miami-Dade County, with an estimated rise to 822,975 in 2005 and an annual growth rate of 1.5%. The average household size in 2004 was 2.85, which was slightly higher than 2.77 in 2000.

Households with incomes under \$25,000 vary significantly by zip codes. The total number of households with incomes under \$25,000 is 256,998 or 31.1%. The largest number of households with incomes less than \$25,000 is in Hialeah (33012) with 9,666 low-income households. Please see Attachment I-A for zip-code specific demographic data on households and poverty levels.

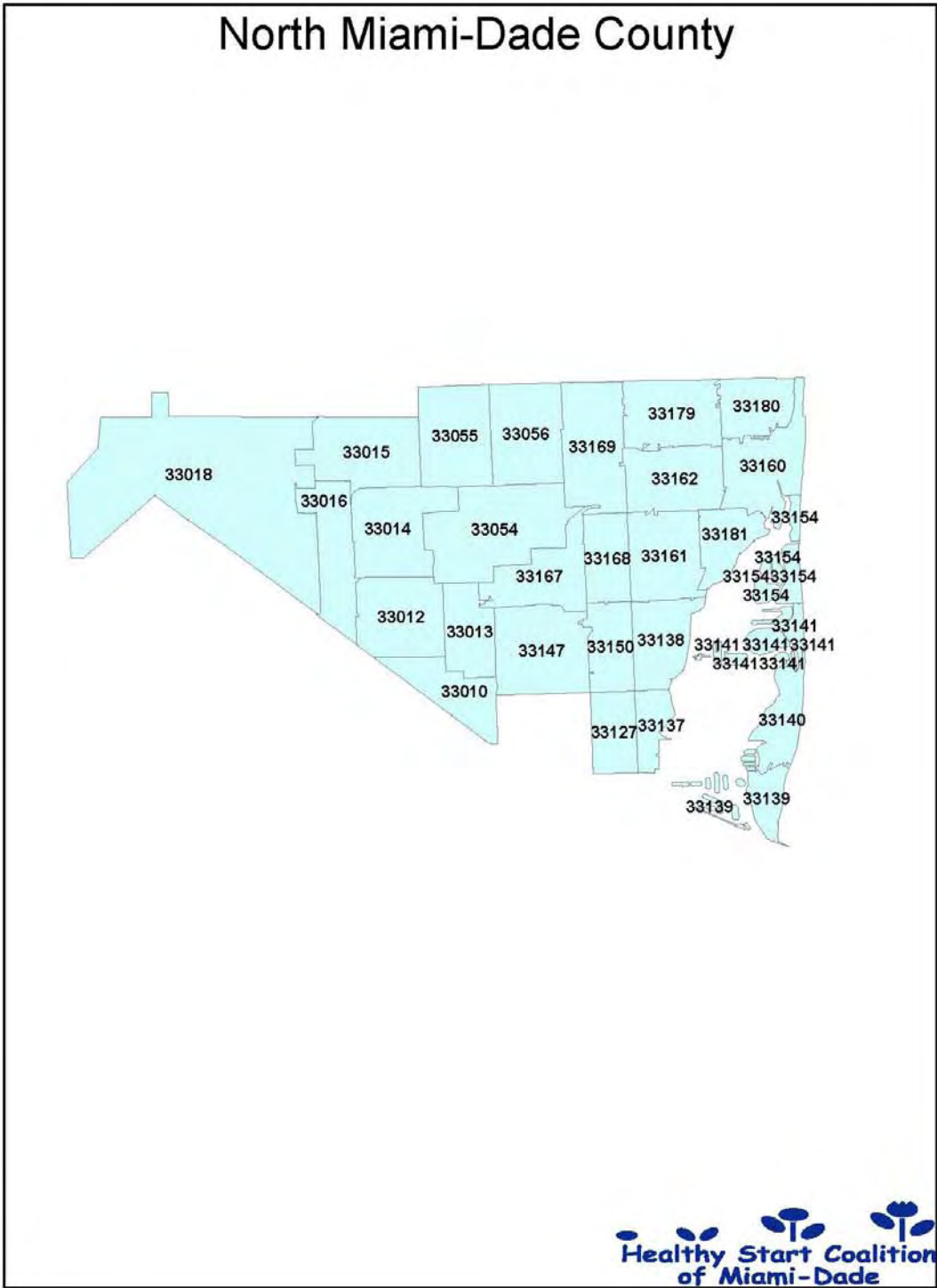
D. INSURED/UNINSURED UNDER AGE 65

Data provided by the Urban Institute and Kaiser Commission indicate that in 2003, 811,637 or 26.7% of the county's population under 65 years of age were uninsured. This estimate is significantly higher than that of the State of Florida average, with a 20.9% uninsured rate, and the United States average, with a 17.7% uninsured rate in 2003. 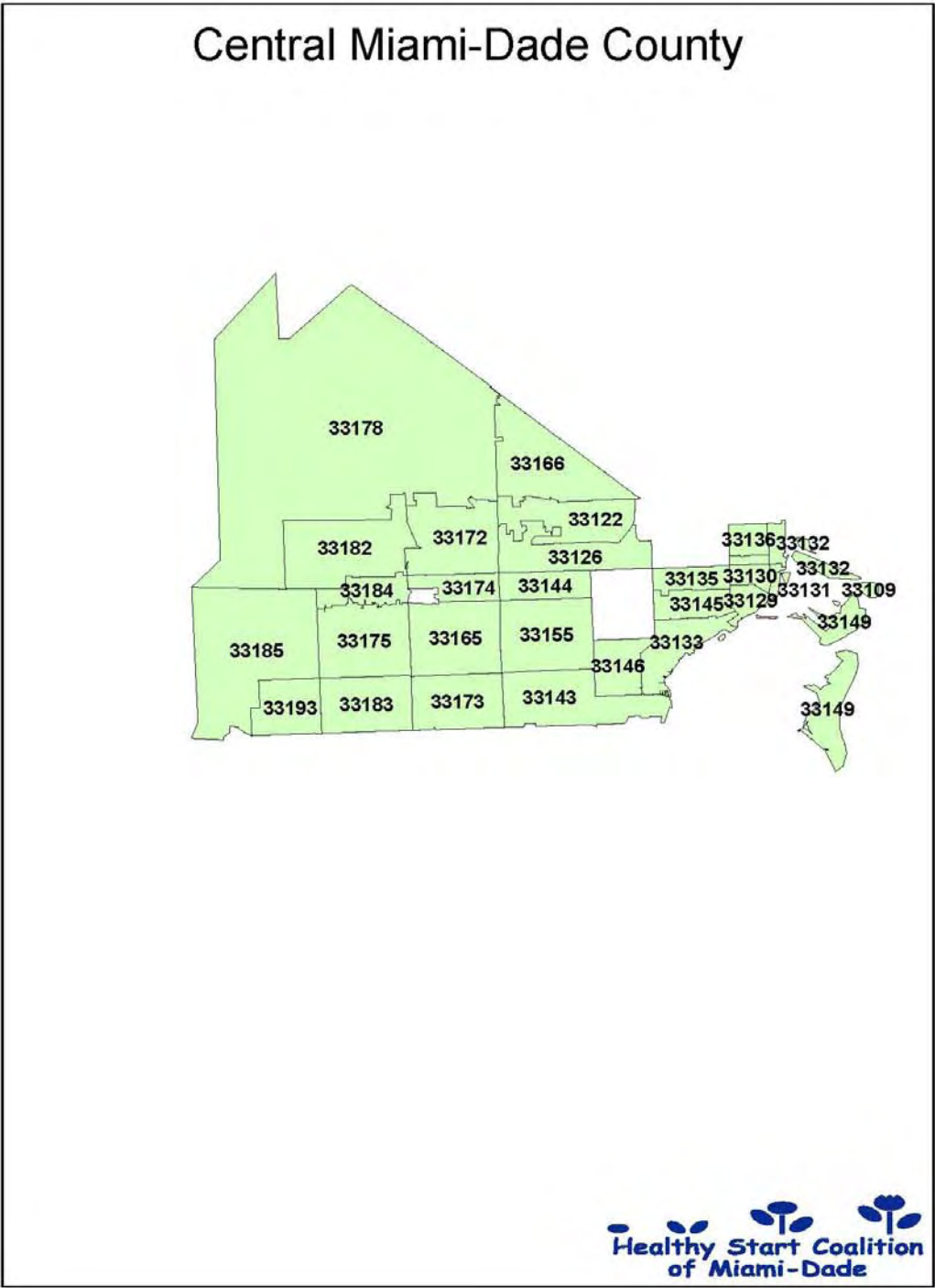
E. MEDICAID POPULATION

The Agency for Health Care Administration reported 941,364 Medicaid recipients in Miami-Dade during April 2005; this figure represents 39% of the total Miami-Dade County population. Of this number, 292,283, or 31%, were females between the ages of 12-55 years old, while 14.6% were 0-5 years old. Data on the Medicaid population in Miami-Dade County can be found in Attachment I-C, toward the end of this section.

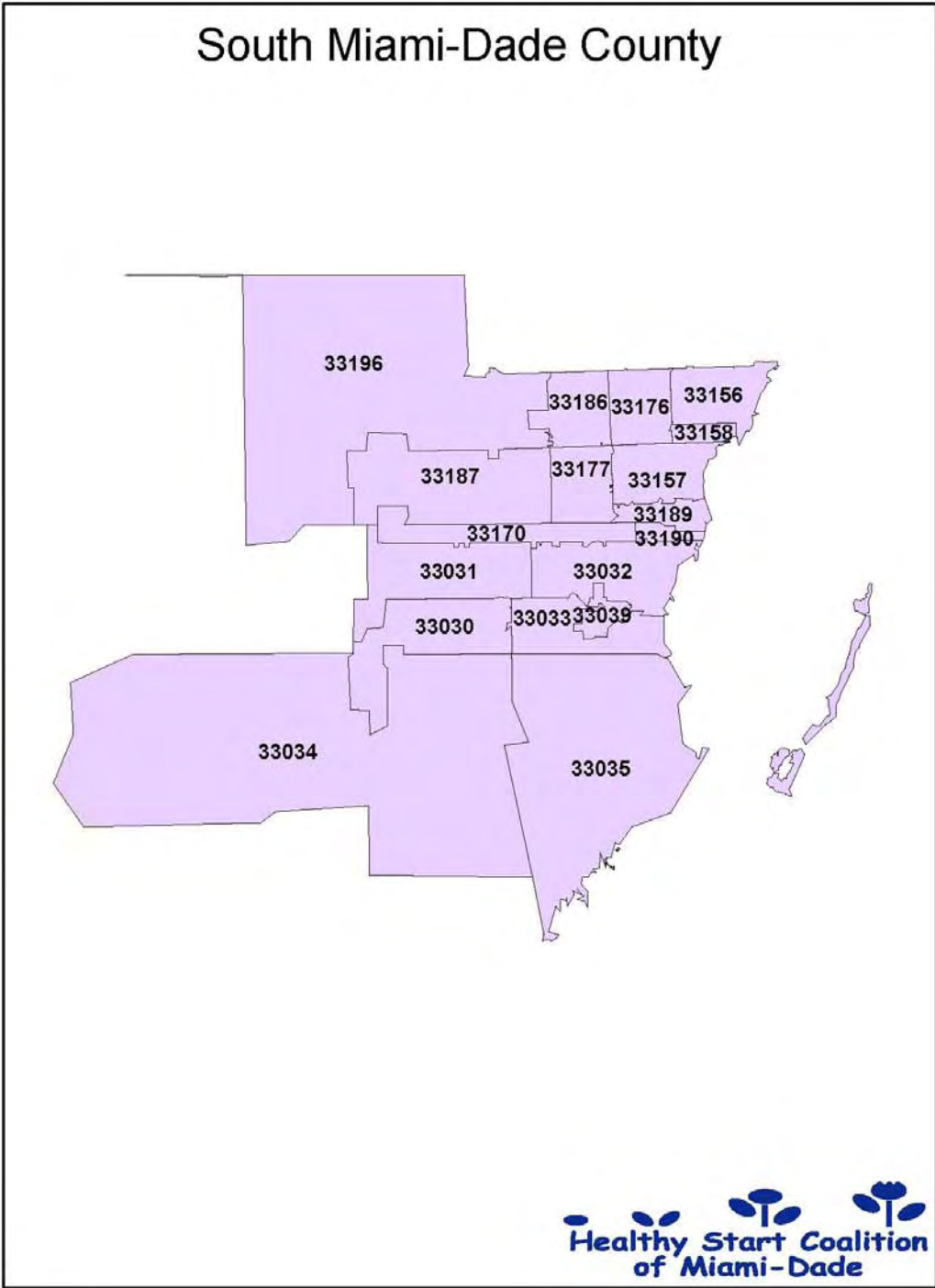
MAP I.1
